Community Resource Database of Long Island

The Community Resource Database of Long Island is a free online directory of health, human service, and education agencies and programs on Long Island. It serves children through adults, families and seniors in Nassau and Suffolk counties. Detailed information is provided for 12,000 community resources. People can utilize information on computers linked to the internet where available. This includes: the workplace, homes, community agencies, schools and libraries. Information is updated on a daily basis.

Included in the Community Resource Database are the following:

- Organizations which provide services in health, welfare, education, advocacy, etc.
- Government agencies (federal, state, county and local) which provide services in the areas of health, welfare, recreation, or education. Not all governmental agencies or departments are listed.
- Organizations (churches, civic groups, and libraries) which offer services to the community.

The Disability Program Navigator Initiative is a collaborative effort of the Suffolk County One-Stop Center, the Suffolk County Workforce Investment Board, VESID and Abilities, Inc.

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- Self-help support groups.
- Not-for-profit environmental, cultural, and recreational organizations.

Organizations outside of our geographic parameters which provide a service not available locally. These may include toll-free help lines if they offer some sort of health or human services.

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
