

The **Medicaid Buy-In Program for Working People with Disabilities** offers people with disabilities who are working, and earning more than the allowable limits for regular Medicaid, the opportunity to keep their health care coverage through Medicaid.

**Eligibility Requirements Include:**

**Age:** Individuals between the ages of 16 to 64 years old.

**Residency:** Must be a New York State resident.

**Disability:** Have a disability as defined by the Social Security Administration.

**Work status:** Must receive a salary as a full-time or part-time worker.

**Citizenship/Immigration Status** This program provides the same medically necessary care generally covered by Medicaid including: **Regular checkups; hospital inpatient and outpatient services; emergency room care; prescription drugs; specialist care; home health care; nursing home care; dental care; prenatal care; smoking cessation agents; medical supplies and equipment.**
