Farmingdale State University is a coeducational, public college with almost 6,000 undergraduate students. Students may choose programs in the areas of business, applied arts and sciences, health sciences and engineering technology. Classes are small, personalized and taught by faculty who provide individual attention. The goal is to prepare students for successful futures. This is done by providing real life applications of knowledge, critical thinking and a solid liberal arts education.

Farmingdale provides support services for students with disabilities. Services include: pre-enrollment information, interview orientation to the campus, registration assistance, academic advisement, appropriate accommodations, tutoring remediation and psychological services. Counseling services include: individual and group sessions for personal and career counseling, advocacy, and disability issues. Documentation of the disability is required and need for appropriate accom-

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modations must be documented also. The goal is to assist students with disabilities to function as independently as possible. This is to ensure a comprehensively accessible university experience where individuals with disabilities have the same access to programs opportunities and activities as all other students.

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
